All diocesan personnel are required to also report violations of The Code of Conduct for Clergy, Employees and Adult Volunteers of the Diocese, Parishes, and Schools to the Diocese Director of the Office of Child and Youth Protection at 417-866-0841 or childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org.

Concerns may be discussed with your supervisor, the Diocese Director of the Office of Child and Youth Protection, or a Victim Assistance Coordinator. Violations and concerns may also be reported using the TIPS online reporting system, accessible through the Diocese webpage, www.dioscg.org.

Failure to Report is a Class A Misdemeanor for a person who is required under the law to report. Filing a False Report is also a Class A Misdemeanor.
